## The SoftBank Group Sustainability Principles

### *Summary*

These Sustainability Principles (these “**Principles**”) have been established by the SoftBank Group (meaning SoftBank Group Corp. and its subsidiaries) pursuant to the SoftBank Group Charter as a guideline for the SoftBank Group's sustainability, so as to contribute to the realization of a sustainable society by meeting the expectations of shareholders, creditors, customers, business partners, employees, local communities, and all other stakeholders.

### *Principles*

#### **Sustainability Vision**

The SoftBank Group has set out the following sustainability vision and will fulfill our responsibility as leader in the Information Revolution to realize a sustainable society in order to create a world where people can live in harmony with the earth, based on the determination to bring happiness to everyone, even to future generations 300 years from now, which is embodied in the SoftBank Group's philosophy of “Information Revolution — Happiness for everyone”.

“Help shape the next 300 years for our future generations and the planet”

#### **Material Issues relating to Sustainability (Material Issues)**

The SoftBank Group will identify material issues relating to sustainability (“**Material Issues**”) that should be addressed with priority in consideration of the importance to the Group and stakeholders. We will set indicators and goals for the Material Issues that should be addressed with priority, and will continuously monitor their progress.

The SoftBank Group will periodically review the Material Issues in consideration of social and business environmental changes surrounding the SoftBank Group.

#### **Promotion of Sustainability Activities**

The SoftBank Group will promote sustainability-related activities based on the recognition that addressing Material Issues and other sustainability-related issues is essential for the sustainable development of society and the medium- to long-term growth of the whole Group, and that they also are opportunities to enhance corporate value beyond the simple prevention and mitigation of risks.

### *Competent Department*

The Sustainability Department of SoftBank Group Corp. is in charge of these Principles.

### *Revision or Repeal*

Any material revision or repeal of these Principles requires a resolution of the Board of Directors of SoftBank Group Corp.

### *Enforcement*

These Principles are partly revised on and enforced from May 1, 2024.
